The Electrician II, CF is responsible for practices, policies and procedures of the Facility Operations established by the Department.

GENERAL STATEMENT

BRIEFLY (1 OR 2 sentences) DESCRIBE THE POSITION'S ORGANIZATIONAL SETTING AND MAJOR FUNCTIONS

Under the general supervision of the Supervisor of Building Trades or the Correctional Plant Supervisor, the Electrician II, CF, is responsible for repair and maintenance of the institutional electrical system, equipment, auxiliary systems, and electrified fence. Plans, lays out, directs and assists with work of assembling, installing, and repairing electric circuits, motors, heaters, generators, transformers, switchboards, and other electrical apparatus, as well as electrified fence and related components. Maintains order and enforces the safety rules and regulations, supervises the conduct of inmates, prevents escapes and injury to themselves, others, or to state property. Maintains security of working areas and work materials. Inmates will be supervised by staff at all times, including movement proceeding to and leaving work areas.

40%	Maintains, installs and repairs electrical machinery and equipment, The incumbent is responsible for planning and making cost estimates of minor electrical projects, preparing purchase documents utilizing the selection of electrical materials, ensures that work is performed according to plans and specifications and is properly correlated with other trades.
30%	Maintenance and care of electrical tools and equipment, keeps records and makes reports, instructs and leads skilled and unskilled inmate workers.

15%	Prevents escapes and injury to inmates and property. Maintain security of working area and work materials, inspects premises and searches inmates for contraband such as weapons or illegal drugs, prepares inmate work reports and timekeeping records.
15%	Prepares purchase orders and requests, receives supplies and maintains tool and material security control programs, provides safety training and enforces safety regulations, completes assignments in energy conservation programs and other job related duties required.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- CDCR does not recognize hostages for bargaining purposes. CDCR has a "NO HOSTAGE" policy and all prison inmates, visitors, nonemployees and employees shall be made aware of this.

CONSEQUENCE OF ERROR

- Consequences of error may result in loss of time and could cause significant delays in program production. Such delays can result in inefficient use or misdirection of department resources resulting in the inability to meet efficiency and time line goals, and varying degrees of negative financial impacts to the department.
