equipment, including self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA). The use of such equipment may place a physiological burden on the incumbent that varies with the type of equipment used, the job and workplace conditions in which the equipment is used, and the medical status of the incumbent. As such, CalOSHA requires that the incumbent be annually medically cleared to be fit-tested for respiratory protection equipment. This clearance process consists of a comprehensive medical evaluation including a review of the incumbent's medical history, a complete physical examination, and vision, hearing, spirometry, and exercise treadmill tests. The incumbent to this position shall be retained for a minimum of a two-year commitment starting on the date of appointment. Any lesser commitment shall be pre-approved by the supervisor to the incumbent. Maintenance of ICS aviation qualifications is required. Frequent short term travel for meetings and emergency incident activity may be required.
