# **Job Summary:**

Under the broad administrative direction of the Product Branch Chief, an Information Technology Manager II, Medi-Cal Enterprise Systems Modernization Division (MESMD), Enterprise Technology Services (ETS), the ITS III serves as the Senior Product Manager for products managed by MESMD.

The MESMD Product Branch manages product development for ETS applications such as MedCompass, Federal Draw & Reporting (FDR), California Automated Recovery Management (Cal-ARM), and Comprehensive Behavioral Health Data Systems Management (CBHDSM) systems. The incumbent will act as Senior Product Manager of the MESMD portfolio exercising expert knowledge of all MESMD product management processes including supporting continuous discovery, design, and implementation of functionality for the MESMD enterprise portfolio that includes MedCompass, FDR, Cal-ARM and CBHDSM systems. The incumbent will also develop and manage an enterprise level product roadmap for these efforts. The incumbent will lead IT Product Managers and Product Owners in IT activities exercising expert knowledge in approved product management strategies, approaches, processes and tools to deliver quality applications. The incumbent will exercise expert knowledge and assist in product planning and execution using Agile and Kanban Methodologies. The incumbent will perform expert-level product reviews, ensuring continuous alignment to enterprise product goals and the enterprise product roadmap. The incumbent will provide expert knowledge of a portfolio plan of approach for managing the many components, systems and processes that are part of the MESMD portfolio.

The incumbent will plan, organize, and lead the activities of multi-disciplinary teams responsible for implementing the product approach and product delivery for the Division's portfolio of modernization products. The incumbent will develop, communicate, measure and improve the organization's product approach and product delivery processes. This Branch is comprised of Information Technology (IT) professionals in various classifications and vendors, who are responsible for the management and delivery of MESMD products within an Agile framework and using a set of Agile tools such as, but not limited to, the Atlassian suite. The ITS III must have experience delivering in an agile product management environment, including experience product planning, strategic planning and developing Product Roadmaps.

The incumbent establishes the appropriate product level goals and objectives that align with IT key initiatives, and develops operational plans according to business priorities and within budget to accomplish the overall MESMD vision and mission. Provides organizational leadership to effectively deliver solutions that support MESMD project management, product planning, product design and discovery, product development and delivery, product implementation, daily business operations, and implement continuous process improvements for MESMD enterprise solutions.

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The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is the designated single state agency responsible for administering California's Medi-Cal Program (Medi-Cal is California's Medicaid program). Medi-Cal is a public health insurance program which provides needed health care services for low-income individuals including families with children, seniors, persons with disabilities, foster care, pregnant women and low income people with specific diseases such as tuberculosis, breast cancer or HIV/AIDS. Medi-Cal is financed equally by the state and federal government. The Medi-Cal program spans across multiple California Health & Human Services (CHHS) departments and DHCS defines California's Medicaid Enterpise System (MES) as the collection of systems and other technical components used by the business processes in the management of the enterprise. MES projects and systems outside of the department include but are not limited to the California Statewide Automated Welfare System (CalSAWS), State Hub, Case Management, Information and Payrolling System (CMIPS) and the California Healthcare Eligibility, Enrollment and Retention System (CalHEERS).
