POSITION'S ORGANIZATIONAL SETTING AND MAJOR FUNCTIONS

Under administrative direction of the Enterprise Systems and Infrastructure Services Bureau Information Technology Manager II, the Information Technology Specialist III (IT Spec III) will lead network architecture for the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration (CDTFA), including all aspects of the enterprise network as well as all networking for the Centralized Revenue Opportunity System (CROS), the tax and fee management system that collects \$70+ Billion in revenue from over 1.3 million taxpayers for the State of California.

As the Network Architect, the IT Spec III will act as a lead to CDTFA network staff. The IT Spec III will provide guidance to, mentor other members of the network and information technology teams, delegate responsibilities and tasks to other Network Administrators (Network Infrastructure Section staff), and monitor their performance without taking over (i.e., to let go but assume responsibility, if necessary). The IT Spec III is responsible for all the work performed by other Network Administrators and should exercise good judgment when delegating responsibilities and tasks. The lead should have an understanding of the FAST Enterprises GenTax application and its environments. The IT Spec III should be an expert in networking technology, including switching, routing, load balancing, firewalls, as well as networking concepts, topologies, and technologies. Travel may be required up to ten percent (10%) of the time.

PERCENTAGE DUTIES **OF TIME SPENT ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS** Architects all CDTFA network infrastructure; including routers/switches, appliances, firewalls, load 60% balancers, wireless access points, wireless controllers, Software Defined Network (SDN) controllers, Intrusion Detection System/Intrusion Prevention System (IDS/IPS), DNS/DHCP, security software, network monitoring, and all other associated current and future software and hardware across Enterprise, Cloud, and CROS Platforms. The architect duties may include analyzing business requirements to develop technical network solutions and their frameworks. Design, test, and inspect network infrastructure systems. Perform network modeling, analysis, and planning. Install network hardware and software systems and components. Develop network technology roadmaps. Develop test plans, implementation plans, and project timelines for various network projects. Manage network technology vendors. Stay abreast on current and future network industry trends and systems that could be used at CDTFA. Write functional requirements/specifications documents. Perform network troubleshooting to isolate and diagnose complex network problems. Upgrade network hardware and software components as required. Technologies/Vendors may include: Cisco, Palo Alto, F5, Citrix, Infoblox HPE, SolarWinds, Splunk, AT&T, Comcast, Microsoft Azure, Amazon Web Services (AWS), and California Department of Technology (CDT) tenant managed Services. Resolving the most complex networking issues in terms of outages/uptime and latency/performance. Analyzing, recommending, planning and implementing large and complex network changes and migrations.
