The division provides IT services, including Data Management, Application Development, Network Support, and Education Technology. The Application Development unit designs, develops, and maintains software applications used by agency staff, the community colleges, and other partners to accomplish the goals and operations of the Community College system. The unit writes specifications for third party and off-the-shelf products and participates as a subject matter expert.

Summary Statement:

Under the general direction of the Director, Application Development and Network Support, and with technical direction from other Information Technology Specialists, the Information Technology (IT) Specialist I develops and maintains software applications in one or more assigned areas. The IT Specialist I develops relationships with customers to gather software requirements and provides support throughout the software development lifecycle. The IT Specialist I engages in team-oriented application development by contributing to multiple projects. The IT Specialist I serves as a consultant to system implementations, including custom applications or off-the-shelf products, by reviewing application architectures and implementing one-time and ongoing integrations.

60% (E)	Develop and maintain mission-critical applications using enterprise standard technologies and platforms. Facilitate system requirements by gathering with customers directly or serving as a business analyst. Implement, test, and deploy necessary changes from resolution of defects, business changes, or prioritized lists of features or requests. Develop and maintain applications using Microsoft's technology platform (SQL Server, .Net Framework, .Net, MVC, Web Forms, and Razor Pages), and web technologies such as HTML, CSS, and Javascript. Use DevOps Services for version control and to collaborate on development tasks and software releases. Provide operational support for applications in other technologies and develop migration plans to standardize to supported technologies. Develop and design application databases, ensuring data integrity, quality, security, and design of data models consistent with business requirements.
20% (E)	Provide technical consulting to projects adopting custom applications or off-the-shelf products. Review technical architecture for compatibility with best practices and Chancellor's Office standards and advise project and division management of issues; Gather requirements, design, and implement one-time or ongoing integrations between systems. Contribute as a subject matter expert in product or vendor evaluations. Develop expertise in low-code development platforms such as ServiceNow, Adobe Sign, and Microsoft Office 365. Become a skilled resource able to coach other developers on integration with 3 rd party products and personally implement pilot efforts and the most complex integrations.

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10% (E)	Contribute to the application development processes such as DevOps, testing, security and other areas by proposing new processes, creating documentation for existing procedures, or contributing during Team working groups such as the Change Advisory Board.
5% (M)	Monitor and research emerging technology in application development or related technology trends to brief the team and Director on upcoming issues or opportunities
5% (M)	Other duties as assigned.
