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- Coordinates care plans with the mental health care treatment team; develops individualized treatment plans, monitors progress, and performs case reviews on a patient caseload. Reviews patient files, gathers data, completes reports and other required documents, participates in patient conferences, prepares and presents case summaries, and consults with other professionals. Completes mental health evaluations for admitted patients including completion of written assessments, evaluations, and other reports. Participates in the individualized treatment planning and discharge planning processes. Provides individual and group therapy as delineated in the treatment plan, provides suicide and crisis risk assessment and intervention; implements and evaluates individual treatment plans, objectives, and dispositions of patients. Coordinates placement with community resources and the Classification and Parole Representative to offer interdisciplinary consultation to clinical/custody staff.
- Coordinates with institutional and custody staff to link institutional services including education, training, work assignments, and special groups participation with the development and implementation of comprehensive treatment plans. Consults with custody staff regarding patient participation and progress in these services.
- Contacts and consults with parole officer staff in the Parole Inpatient Clinics, patients' family members, and outside resources as appropriate to enhance the patient's adjustment to the prison setting and to facilitate successful release into the community. Participates in program evaluation and quality assessment and improvement. Coordinates placement with community resources and the Classification and Parole Representative to offer interdisciplinary consultation to clinical/custody staff.
- Reviews court and clinical regulatory requirements for clinical documentation and overall clinical case management of assigned patients. Attends case conferences and other meetings as required.
- **5%** Performs other duties as required.

## **KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES**

Knowledge of: Principles, procedures, techniques, trends, and literature of social work with particular reference to clinical social work; psycho/social aspects of mental, developmental, and physical disabilities; community organization principles; scope and activities of public and private health and welfare agencies; characteristics of mental, developmental, and physical disabilities; and current trends in mental health, public health and welfare, and federal and State programs in these fields.

Ability to: Utilize and effectively apply the required technical knowledge; establish and maintain the confidence and cooperation of persons contacted in the work; secure accurate psycho/social data and record such data systematically; prepare clear, accurate, and concise reports; work family and community agencies in preparation for discharge; develop and implement programs; provide professional consultation; analyze situations accurately and take effective action; and communicate effectively.

#### LICENSE REQUIREMENT

Possession of a valid license as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker issued by the California Board of Behavioral Science.

# **DRUG TESTING REQUIREMENT**

## SPECIAL PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Persons appointed to the class of Clinical Social Worker (Health/CF) Safety are reasonably expected to have and maintain sufficient strength, agility, and endurance to perform during physically, mentally, and emotionally stressful situations encountered on the job without compromising their health and well-being or that of their fellow employees, patients, or the incarcerated.

Assignments may include sole responsibility for the control of patients, clients, or the incarcerated and the protection of personal and real property.

## SPECIAL PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS

- Influence change and strengthen the community. Set an example each day through positive and pro-social role modeling, utilizing dynamic security concepts.
- Willingness to play a significant role in the collaborative efforts toward rehabilitation and public safety enhancement.
- Ability to facilitate conversations as a coach and mentor, engaging in a respectful and understanding manner.
- Ability to build trust, improve communication, and assist with the transformation of correctional culture.
- Objective and empathic understanding of individuals with the mental, developmental, or physical disabilities.
- Flexibility to alter hours as needed; tolerance; tact; emotional stability; and respect for persons from diverse backgrounds.
