Percentage of Time Required	Effective on the date indicated, the employee assigned to the position identified above performs the following duties and responsibilities.		
40%	<u>The Heavy Equipment Mechanic (HEM) works under the direction of the Division Chief – West Operations to maintain the Placer County Fire Department (PCFD) Fleet. The position is located at Auburn Shop; however, field repairs and inspections will be required throughout the Nevada-Yuba-Placer Unit (NEU). The HEM may be required to work with incarcerated individuals at Conservation Camps, Auburn Shop, and other locations.</u> <u>MOBILE EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE</u> <u>*Maintains and repairs vehicles for PCFD Fleet including fire engines, aerial apparatus, water tenders, support and command vehicles, as well as assist other Unit HEMs in maintaining the CAL FIRE NEU Fleet. *These vehicles must be maintained in compliance with Department of Transportation (DOT) and California Highway Patrol (CHP) laws, and California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) Mobile Equipment Policy and Procedures. *Per Vehicle Code Section 1232, the HEM performs periodic, preventive maintenance inspections; including but not limited to: brake components, adjustments, system leaks and testing; two-way check valve in dual air system; draining and recharging primary and secondary air reservoirs; all tank mounting brackets and frame rails; assess and repair engine belts and hoses, tires, wheels, steering, suspension; and evaluate the overall safety of vehicles.</u>		
25%	<u>FIELD TYPE REPAIRS</u> <u>*Repairs equipment at various locations throughout the Unit. *Mechanical repairs and inspection intervals will be maintained and recorded. *When dispatched by the Grass Valley Interagency Emergency Command Center, the HEM must be available for emergency response. *The HEM may be required to respond to emergency incidents anywhere in the State to repair and maintain mobile equipment. *Mechanical duties involve diagnosis and maintenance on diesel and gasoline engines.</u> <u>*These are the essential functions for this position. Essential functions are those functions that the individual who holds the position must be able to perform unaided or with the assistance of a reasonable accommodation.</u>

Must successfully pass a pre-employment medical evaluation, drug pre-screen test, and be enrolled in the Federal Department of Transportation Random Pull Program. May be required to work nights, weekends, and holidays.

PROCUREMENT AND RECORD KEEPING

*Makes purchases, as needed, keeps inventory of small parts and materials, etc. Following CAL FIRE Policies and Procedures, prepares estimates on parts purchasing over \$100 as well as parts and labor over \$1,000. Completes purchase order pay documents to support the mobile equipment repairs for NEU vehicles. Prepares and completes Shop Work Orders as required to properly report work performed. Completes Faulty Equipment Reports, compliance inspections and other detailed reports as necessary. Completes monthly Purchasing Card (P-Card) purchasing documents for reconciliation. Reconciles parts after an incident and inputs information into a computer database. Provides technical direction and guidance to other personnel performing preventive maintenance.

TRAINING

Receives specialized training in fire apparatus repair and maintenance as required to become proficient in this position. Assists in presenting training to fire control personnel on apparatus care and maintenance. *Maintain mechanical skills through competency training related to CAL FIRE Equipment Repair that is available. *Utilize diagnostic software and computer to properly diagnose equipment.

Other duties as assigned.

The incumbent is required to wear respiratory protection equipment (including self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA). The use of such equipment may place a physiological burden on the incumbent that varies with the type of equipment used, the job and workplace conditions in which the equipment is used, and the medical status of the incumbent. As such, the California Occupational Safety and Health Administration (Cal/OSHA) requires that the incumbent be annually medically cleared to be fit-tested for respiratory protection equipment. This clearance process consists of a comprehensive medical evaluation including a review of the incumbent's medical history, a complete physical examination, and vision, hearing, spirometry, and exercise treadmill test.

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
