Coordinate and report on all product releases. Serves as an associate subject matter expert for web products, including but not limited to hospitalization, financial, claims, and encounter data. Provides technical assistance to both internal and external data users as a subject matter expert. Manage and maintain product inventory, product improvement, and product business intelligence tools. In a Department and Branch liaison role, participate in product governance, web governance, and digital services engagement governance groups.

Participate in collaborative efforts with program staff across HCAI, the HCAI web team, information technology staff, OIS management and the Director's Office. Develop tools to engage stakeholders for feedback on usability of Data and Reports webpage for data products and apply industry best practices to define how data products are presented and how users will interact with the site. Ensure interfaces meet standard architecture set by the web team and best practices. Serve as the end user to ensure all healthcare analytic product designs are usable, intuitive and conform to industry standards. Provides technical assistance to both internal and external data users as a subject matter expert.
