35%	<p>Under the general supervision of the Deputy Chief of Operations, the Forestry Equipment Manager I (FEM I) is responsible for overseeing the maintenance and repair of all automotive equipment assigned to Schedule A and B programs within the Amador – El Dorado Unit (AEU).</p> <p>*Supervises the Heavy Equipment Mechanics (HEM) assigned to the El Dorado Automotive Shop. *Acts as the automotive repair advisor for the HEMs assigned to Pine Grove Conservation Camp, Growlersburg Conservation Camp. *Ensures adherence to preventative maintenance programs and repair protocols. *Coordinates and monitors shop operations to maintain fleet readiness with departmental and operational needs. *Maintains and monitors the shop's operations to ensure that all Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and safety standards are met.</p>	
30%	<p>*Establishes and reviews annual maintenance and safety inspections for all fleet vehicles and ensures all associated records are updated aligning with departmental and operational needs.</p> <p>*Responsible for the planning, budgeting and implantation of vehicle and equipment procurement, replacement and disposal. *Maintains inventory or stocked parts and supplies.</p>	
20%	<p>*Manages expenditures within allocated fleet budgets for repairs, maintenance, tools or accessories.</p> <p>*Establishes and maintains standardized inspection, maintenance and pump testing schedules in accordance with California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection's (CAL FIRE) policies as well as any state and federal regulations that may apply. *Investigates automotive accidents when requested to determine the amount of damage and method of repair needed. *Develops and presents automotive maintenance and operation trainings to unit personnel.</p>

10%	*During emergency situations, the FEM I may be required to establish ground support operations and demobilization (DEMOB) efforts. *Oversees emergency fleet repair and coordinates with local vendors to ensure availability of repair and support services during critical incident.	
5%	Other duties as required.	
<p>The incumbent is required to wear respiratory protection equipment (including self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA). The use of such equipment may place a physiological burden on the incumbent that varies with the type of equipment used, the job and workplace conditions in which the equipment is used, and the medical status of the incumbent. As such, Cal/OSHA requires that the incumbent be annually medically cleared to be fit-tested for respiratory protection equipment. This clearance process consists of a comprehensive medical evaluation including a review of the incumbent's medical history, a complete physical examination, and vision, hearing, spirometry, and exercise treadmill tests</p>		
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Job qualifications and/or conditions of employment: Maintains the Arduous Fitness Standard in accordance with department policy. May be subject to working nights, weekends, or holidays.
