PSYCHIATRIC TECHNICIAN TRAINEE (SAFETY)

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

As an employee of the facility LOC Registry, a Psychiatric Technician Trainee may be requested to work AM/PM/NOC shift, any day of the week and on any residence at the Developmental Center. Under the direction of Unit Supervisor or SRPT/NPIC, he/she assists in providing direct care, treatment and active treatment for the clients where they are assigned.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under the supervision of a licensed staff. Can be assigned the following duties, provide training, enrich their experience, to develop a better understanding of clients and to help our clients achieve the maximum level of their abilities.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Must possess and maintain sufficient strength, agility, endurance and sensory abilities to perform the duties contained in this duty statement.

TYPICAL WORKING CONDITIONS

Ongoing interaction with clients, personnel and the general public. Potential exposure to communicable diseases, blood borne pathogens and other conditions common to a clinical nursing environment.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- 10% Prompts and assist the client in developing and increasing their level of participation in daily living skills.
- 10% Provides clients with appropriate attention in an individualized fashion. Takes a positive behavioral approach to each individual entrusted in their care.
- 10% Assists in providing direct care, training and recreation of client that is consistent with their individual habilitation plan.
- 10% Assists clients in areas of need, recognizing the integrity and dignity of clients and their rights as individuals.
- 10% Assists in carrying out client treatment plans.
- 10% Observes and records clients behavior and condition, and reports to their immediate supervisor.
Interdisciplinary Notes must be co-signed by a licensed Psychiatric Technician.
- 4% May accompany group leader on trips to the Oasis and trips to assist clients in community

awareness activities and use of community facilities.

- 2% Escorts clients to clinics, classes and other activities.
- 2% Assists in accounting for clients at change of shift.
- 10% Helps to create a safe and therapeutic environment.
- 2% Submits written reports as requested.
- 10% Complies with program and facility policies and procedures.
- 10% Performs other duties as assigned by the unit supervisor or SRPT/NPIC
