<p>Under the direction of the Senior Environmental Scientist Supervisor (Coastal Programs), the Senior Environmental Scientist (Specialist) serves as a member of the interdisciplinary Coastal Resilience (CORE) Program, supporting the implementation of the Department’s Sea Level Rise Adaptation Strategy. Provides scientific and technical expertise to inform project formulation, evaluation of adaptation strategies, and integration of climate resilience into operational processes, projects, and programs. Working collaboratively with the CORE Program members, districts, divisions, and partner agencies, the incumbent supports permitting and environmental compliance, interagency coordination, and the application of best available science to guide planning, restoration, and coastal adaptation efforts.</p>

30%	<p>CORE Program Development and Implementation</p> <p>Work as a team member of the Department’s Coastal Resilience Program (Program), supporting the development and implementation of Program goals and initiatives. Provide expert environmental compliance and permitting support to program planning, coordination, and communication across divisions. Provide technical assistance to the districts. Assist with partnership development and government relations with regulatory agencies on elements of the Department’s Sea Level Rise Adaptation Strategy. Support program reporting, preparation of materials, and coordination of meetings and workshops to promote collaboration and effective implementation of coastal resilience efforts statewide.</p>	
30%	<p>Systemwide Support to District Programs</p> <p>Provide leadership and expertise to districts on project formulation, scope of work development, cost estimating, and implementation of coastal resilience projects. Evaluate adaptation strategies using site data and climate projections and coordinate with other Program members and divisions to ensure policy alignment. Engage with regulatory agencies on environmental compliance and permitting. Review and track project agreements and funding allocations, report progress to leadership, and support grant writing, reporting, and records management.</p>	
25%	<p>Coastal Permitting and Technical Support</p>	

	Provide scientific and technical support for environmental compliance, permitting, and interagency coordination related to sea level rise adaptation and coastal resilience projects. Assist districts and divisions with preparation of permit applications and review of technical documents to ensure consistency with State Parks' internal policy and applicable regulations, including California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), and Coastal Act. Coordinate with regulatory agencies to facilitate project delivery. Support development of best practices and guidance to improve efficiency, consistency, and scientific rigor in permitting and project implementation.	
10%	Policy and Guidance Support the development of Department policy, guidance, and procedures related to sea level rise adaptation, coastal resilience, and natural resource management. Collaborate with divisions and districts to identify policy gaps and ensure consistency with State Parks' mission, statutory authorities, and the Sea Level Rise Adaptation Strategy. Review and synthesize emerging science, regulatory updates, and best practices to inform policy development and decision-making.
