30%	In a learner capacity, assist Research Data Specialist in the exploration and documentation of the architecture of existing databases, including relationships, dependencies, and integration points with other systems through the analysis of data. Assist with identifying data fields are copied and harmonized from source databases. Assist in Data Field Mapping of inventory and cross-reference key data fields across contributing databases to support programming. Assist with researching and reviewing the identification of redundancies, inconsistencies, and unique fields that need to be preserved for the future enterprise system.
30%	In a learner capacity, assist Research Data Specialist with gap analysis, schema alignment, and data harmonization to support programming. Assist with the research, analysis, and review to develop data dictionaries, entity relationship diagrams, and flowcharts that capture how data is ingested, stored, and served. Assist with review of documentation for clarity for stakeholders. Assist with the translation of findings into actionable insights for migration planning. Assist with documenting discussions on transition strategy and lessons learned from existing systems.

Assist with the refactoring and translating of code (e.g., Python, R, or SQL-based logic) for efficient computation in Snowflake.
