<p>Under the close supervision of the Aquatic Pest Control Assistant Program Manager, the Aquatic Pest Control Technician treats aquatic weeds in the Delta to ensure a healthy aquatic environment is maintained within the Delta. The Aquatic Pest Control Technician will perform maintenance on various types of boats and boating accessories to ensure water safety and will safely handle and administer chemical aquatic weed treatments that follow environmental standards. The Aquatic Pest Control Technician will also record inventory and environmental data related to aquatic weed treatments.</p> <p>The Aquatic Pest Control Technician will report to 4990 Buckley Cove Way, Stockton, CA.</p>

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:		
%	TASK/DUTIES	
35%	Assist the Aquatic Pest Control Specialist in the safe navigation and maintenance of different types of boats, boat trailers, tow vehicles and mechanical harvesting equipment in the Delta and shallow rivers and at times, during extreme weather. Assist in the maintenance and minor repairs of equipment including boats, spray gear, automotive and other transport equipment. Assist in maintaining detailed equipment maintenance records to ensure equipment is performing to department and division standards to complete mission critical tasks, such as controlling invasive aquatic plants.	
35%	Assist the Aquatic Pest Control Specialist in safe and efficient operation and maintenance of application equipment and chemical handling for aquatic weed treatment. When necessary, lead boat crew on the spray application effort. Learn and assist in carrying out varied tasks in biological field work, such as environmental observations like weather, hydrologic conditions and plant identification.	
15%	Assist the Aquatic Pest Control Specialist in accurately monitoring and recording treatment conditions, including mapping, data recording, daily reporting, inventory, computer entry, in-water plant or fish census, and small reports. Assist in future treatment area selection and treatment scheduling. Attend appropriate continuing education classes to maintain required pesticide applicator's licenses.	
10%	Effectively communicate with division/department staff, cooperating agencies, and the public about field situations and actions taken.

TYPICAL WORKING CONDITIONS		
Traverse uneven terrain and boat activities in rugged outdoor environments and inclement weather. The incumbent must be able to meet the demands of field work in aquatic environments. Specifically, they must be able to swim at least 50 yards and stay afloat for at least 10 minutes, ability to reboard vessels unassisted from the water, in the event of unexpected disembarking from the vessel, function in rough waters without incapacitation due to seasickness and transport equipment up to 50 pounds. Required to drive to field study locations and to off-site meetings.
