POSITION'S ORGANIZATIONAL SETTING AND MAJOR FUNCTIONS  Under the close supervision of the Business Taxes Administrator (BTA), I, the Business Taxes Representative (BTR) performs tax compliance work which may include assisting license inspections, administrative seizures of cigarette and tobacco products, and cannabis products, and gaining compliance of unlicensed businesses. The BTR also prepares appropriate inspection documents and may contribute to seizure reports, may conduct field observations, assist in identifying interrelated fraud schemes, and perform other related duties to ensure compliance with tax laws, including the licensing and reporting requirements. Travel may be required up to 50% of the time, including overnight stays.  <b>Candidate must be able to perform the following essential job functions with or without reasonable accommodation.</b>

75%	<p><b><u>ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS</u></b></p> <p>Assists with inspections of businesses that sell cigarettes, tobacco products, and cannabis to identify compliance issues with the tax laws administered by the CDTFA. Uses current cigarette stamp verification equipment and reconciles other tobacco products inventory and invoices. Uses CROS, the Investigations Tracking System, and other background research tools to ascertain true ownership and to avoid compromising an active criminal investigation. Uses investigative procedures and techniques to complete routine inspections, which require conducting, documenting field observations, advising taxpayers, documenting statements of taxpayers regarding potential criminal tax evasion activities, and recording inspection findings, which may include administrative seizures of cigarettes and tobacco products as forfeited to the state pursuant to the Revenue and Taxation Code. Communicates, educates, and gathers information from taxpayers and their representatives, other agencies, and the public.</p> <p>Assists with conducting inspections of businesses selling cannabis products. Assists the Limited Peace Officers (LPOs) in processing the non-LPO necessary paperwork related to inspections, including the opening and closing of complaints. Prepares appropriate inspection documents and may contribute to seizure reports, including counting, documenting, &amp; photographing of seizures. Documents field observations, advises taxpayers, documents taxpayers' statements regarding potential criminal tax evasion activities, and prepares inspection findings reports. This may involve administrative seizures of cigarettes, tobacco, and cannabis products being forfeited to the state pursuant to tax laws administered by the Inspections Bureau.</p>		
20%	<p>Communicates with taxpayers, representatives, and other agencies to gather and verify information supporting licensing and reporting compliance. Provides guidance to promote voluntary compliance and participates in joint inspections and collaborative enforcement efforts as required. Provides assistance to taxpayers to ensure compliance with the tax laws; participates in meetings with law enforcement and other state agencies relating to joint inspections.</p> <p><b><u>MARGINAL JOB FUNCTIONS</u></b></p>

**Work Environment:**

- May work in a high-rise building
- Standard office environment
- Parking varies by location
- Exposure to cannabis, nicotine, and other related products is deemed potentially hazardous.

**Physical Abilities:**

- Remain in a stationary position for extended periods of time to meet operational needs and critical deadlines.
- Use a computer/laptop, office equipment, and telephone daily.
- Ability to transfer and transport materials, supplies, and equipment weighing up to thirty (30) pounds with or without reasonable accommodation.
- Withstand possible impairment and/or contamination from cannabis products or odor.
- Ability to transport materials (including cannabis and tobacco products) up to fifty (50) pounds with or without reasonable accommodation.

**Additional Requirements/Expectations:**

- Travel may be required to meet training requirements, which may include overnight.
- Must be flexible and willing to adjust to changing work schedules, if required, for operational needs.
- Travel to and work at assigned field sites, to meet operational needs, which may include overnight
- The position may be called to testify in administrative hearing matters and criminal court proceedings.
- This position is designated as a mobile worker position and will require an incumbent to spend the majority of their time (fifty percent or more) working at various locations other than their home or office in a single day (CMAP 1014).
