FUNCTION OF POSITION

Under the close supervision of the Sergeant, the Commercial Vehicle Inspection Specialist is responsible for working at highway inspection facilities performing inspections of commercial motor vehicles to determine compliance with weight, size, registration, safety, and equipment requirements. Conducting commercial vehicle inspections is part of the Department's Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Program. Inspecting these vehicles to ensure they are in compliance with the policies and procedures set forth in the California Highway Patrol Commercial Enforcement Manual, the Vehicle Equipment Inspection Guide and for the Mission Grade Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Facility.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

The Commercial Vehicle Inspection Specialist reports directly to and receives the majority of their assignments from the Sergeant. However, direction and assignments may also come from the Lieutenant.

Essential Functions

55%	Inspect and test integral commercial vehicle components and systems for compliance with the Vehicle Code and other applicable laws and regulations. At a minimum, ensure inspected commercial vehicles meet or exceed the established Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) safety standards. Refer all identified violations to the on-duty commercial officer for review and possible enforcement action. They affix CVSA inspection stickers to vehicles which pass inspection.
25%	Assist the commercial officer in a supporting role to provide security for the facility and bring suspected criminal activity or unusual occurrences to the attention of the on-duty commercial officer. Review incoming commercial technical manuals and information bulletins. Prepare and conduct commercial training to departmental and allied agency personnel. Provide service to the public in person and via telephone regarding a wide variety of commercial vehicle operations; driver qualifications, hours of service, load securement as well as mechanical questions.
15%	Monitor commercial vehicle driver qualification and compliance with state and federal laws. Set-up and maintain commercial regulation manuals, maintain facility resources and issued personnel inspection equipment. Perform other duties as assigned by their facility supervisors to aid the facility in accomplishing the mission of the California Highway Patrol.
