40%	POSITION SUMMARY Under direction of the Senior Environmental Scientist (Supervisory) of the Compliance, Permitting, and Mitigation Unit within the CEQA and NEPA Support Section of the Environmental Services Branch, the incumbent is responsible for assisting with the Delta Conveyance Project environmental compliance activities. As a matrixed multi-disciplinary environmental team, the Environmental Services Branch provides comprehensive and specialized environmental regulatory compliance services to support the Department's wide range of activities. Delta Conveyance Project environmental compliance activities include conducting complex studies and analyses, addressing sensitive species issues, and obtaining environmental permits to comply with State and federal laws and regulations. Incumbents work products will be reviewed at all stages to ensure achievement of Delta Conveyance Project objectives and conformity with department policy. ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS This position requires the incumbent to work cooperatively with others; deal effectively with the public and other interested parties; maintain regular, consistent, and predictable attendance; exercise good judgment; and accept changes in priorities assigned, based on operational need. The incumbent will assist with developing plans, collecting and managing environmental data, conducting technical studies, and developing permit applications. This will require driving a State vehicle on public roadways and uneven terrain and on a boat. The specific essential functions are: Mitigation Team and Permit Coordination Team: Assist supervisor and other team members, including DWR staff, consultants, State and federal agencies, and interested parties, with developing and implementing mitigation actions and obtaining various State and federal environmental permits. Assist in performing a variety of studies and analyses identified by Delta Conveyance Office Management to complete the Delta Conveyance Program permitting process to facilitate Program implementation.

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40% cont.	Design and conduct environmental studies in the Delta to assess impacts of activities or fill data gaps. Evaluate, analyze, monitor, and provide recommendations on the development and implementation of Delta Conveyance Program mitigation actions, including restoration projects and other commitments. Coordinate permits by evaluating the need for, timing of, and processes involved in authorizations expected during Program implementation. These activities may require conducting or coordinating environmental surveys to collect environmental data and managing associated environmental databases.				
40%	Delta Conveyance Program Document Preparation: As part of an interagency Program team, the incumbent will review and comment on planning and environmental documents that identify environmental impacts associated with the Program area, species related impacts, and activities of the Delta Conveyance Program. Assist in the development of various topic areas of the California Environmental Quality Act/National Environmental Policy Act Environmental Impact Report/ Environmental Impact Statement, Biological Assessment, and Incidental Take Permit Application, among others, and with disposition or resolution of public and multi-agency comments. Coordinate team meetings and prepare documents needed to obtain permits.				
15%	Assist with the preparation of draft memorandum, reports, and documents for the Unit Manager, Section Manager, Branch Manager, Division Manager, and/or Delta Conveyance Office Management. Incumbent will participate in technical workshops, conferences, and scientific symposia; make technical presentations to various intra- and inter-agency working groups and scientific organizations.				
5%	Support Environmental Compliance efforts in the Environmental Services Branch and for other State Water Project (SWP)-related projects and activities: Design and conduct environmental studies needed to analyze potential State and federal environmental impacts of SWP-related activities and to ensure State and federal environmental compliance. Review and provide recommendations on environmental documents; evaluate the need for, timing of, and processes involved in authorizations required; and prepare documents needed to obtain permits. Employee must work in close partnership with the NEPA and CEQA Support Section and function within a matrixed, multi-disciplinary team within the Branch, Division, and Department-wide, and with federal, State, and local agencies and interested parties.				
SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS					
A valid California driver's license is required to drive to various field locations and meetings. Travel on short notice and overnight lodging may be required on some trips to various field locations and meetings. The position requires that the incumbent have the ability to: 1) establish and maintain cooperative working relationships as part of an interdisciplinary and interagency team; 2) have a working knowledge of general principles of ecology and California and Delta fauna and/or flora; 3) ability to access habitat improvement project sites that often requires using a boat or crossing rough and steep terrain and meet the demands of field work in terrestrial and aquatic habitats; 4) able to function without incapacitation due to sea-sickness; 5) swim at least 50 yards					

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	and stay afloat at least 10 minutes; 6) review and analyze scientific data, using appropriate statistical and analytical methods, for accuracy and compliance reach sound conclusions and take effective action; 7) speak and write effectively; 8) use a PC and utilize Word and Excel, and; 9) maintain a level of professional integrity and trustworthiness commensurate with responsibilities. Incumbent must also act as the Unit Manager when required. 10) All employees are responsible for contributing to an inclusive, safe, and secure work environment that values diverse cultures, perspectives, and experiences, and is free from discrimination.
